

Getting on SCCC's Wireless Internet with Mac OS X

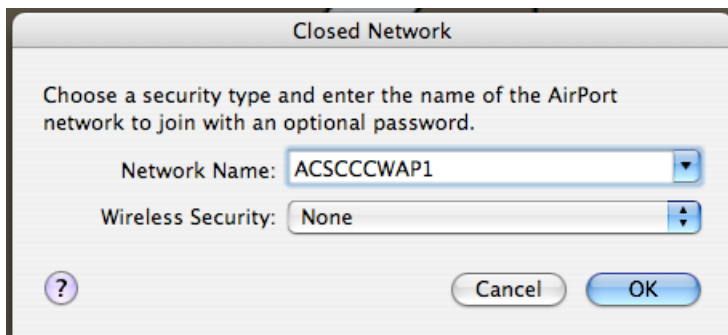
Requires MacOS X 10.3 or later with Airport Wireless Card

Wireless is available in the library, outside the library, in the computer lab, and in the commuter lounge/cafeteria area.

1) Under your Airport signal menu, choose "Other...".

2) For **Wireless Security**, choose "None".

3) For **Network Name**, type "ACSCCCWAP1". You may have to type this every time, and if its tough to remember, for future reference, its short for "Academic Computing SCCC Wireless Access Point 1". You should now see a signal in the airport menu.



4) Open a web browser with pop-up's allowed. It should bring you to a page asking for a log-in. Type in your Angel name/password. By default your name is the first 6 letters of your last name, first initial, and middle initial. So Booker T Washington would be "washinbt". Your default password is your birthday plus "@sccc". Booker was born on April 5, 1856, so his password would be "040556@sccc". It is highly recommended to change your password from the default.

5) When you click log in, a pop up window will appear (make sure you don't have pop-ups blocked), which needs to stay open during the time you're online. It can be minimized out of the way though. You're now online.
