

Usage Agreement

Abstract from SCCC Computer Use Policies and Procedures Section III

Part I (Wireless Policy):

- Actions that violate SCCC policies, SUNY policies, Federal or NY State law are not permitted from any SCCC network connection.
- Wireless connections are firewall restricted and require authentication via the College's wireless access system.
- There is no limitation on connection time through wireless access. Periodic re-authentication may be necessary to ensure quality of service.
- For wireless access, the client operating system must use dynamic IP address assignment via Dynamic Host Configuration Protocol (DHCP). The default DHCP lease time is set to 8 hours. The DHCP lease is renewed automatically as long as the port is in use.
- Only TCP/IP protocols will be routed to wireless access.
- Wireless access traffic must abide by acceptable use restrictions. For example:
 - No commercial use.
 - No malicious actions, such as denial of service attacks.
 - No harassment of other computer users.
 - No distribution of pornographic materials.
 - No copyright violations.
 - No offering of DHCP or Domain Name Services (DNS).
 - No advertising of network routing information.
 - No use of file-sharing software (e.g. Kazaa) or other bandwidth intensive applications that may degrade quality of service.
 - IP address assignment via DHCP for all wireless access is required. You may not set an IP address in your machine's configuration when using this service.
 - If the College receives complaints of improper activity, an immediate cessation of that activity is expected upon notification to the user.
 - Ports may be disabled on an emergency basis to stop violations of acceptable use restrictions.

Failure to abide by these policies may result in loss of access to network and computing resources, College disciplinary action and/or other legal action.

Guarantee of service:

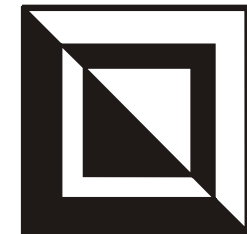

About

The SCCC Wireless system allows students with laptops to utilize the campus Internet connection from the familiar interface of their computer.

The SCCC Wireless system is currently installed in the following areas:

- ◆ **Begley Building** Lobby outside of the auditorium and inside the auditorium.
- ◆ **Begley Library** Both floors in archival areas.
- ◆ **Center for Science and Technology** 1st floor and 3rd floor lobbies.
- ◆ **Elston Hall** Commons area including the Activity Forum.
- ◆ **Elston Hall** Culinary Wing 1st floor.
- ◆ **Elston Hall** Hallway of Main Computer Lab 5th floor.
- ◆ **Stockade Building** 1st floor, lecture centers 101, 102.

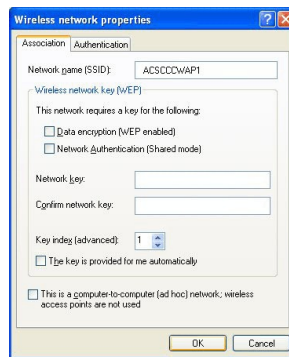
Please Note: Windows XP, Windows Vista and Windows 7 have been tested and are supported. Mac OS X 10.7.2 introduced a bug that makes the system incompatible with the authentication process used on the wireless system. If you use Mac OS X 10.7.2 and experience issues logging in, please come to the Elston Hall 530 main computer lab. You may be able to use alternate operating systems, however we will not support their proper operation while on the network.

Getting Online (Wireless Setup)

Create a new wireless profile with the following settings:

SSID: ACSCCCWAP1
Authentication: Open
Encryption: None/Disabled *

Once you have associated, your computer will receive an IP address via DHCP allocation. At this point, you may move on to authentication.

Getting Online (Authenticating)

**** Please note: You MUST allow pop-ups from the securelogin.arubanetworks.com domain.****

Open an Internet browser window to any site. You will be redirected to the authentication form.

Provide your SCCC User ID and Password** in the spaces provided.

Contact the Academic Computing department in the Elston 530 main computer lab to complete a wireless guest authorization form and receive temporary login credentials.

Once you have logged in successfully, you will get a pop-up window “SCCC Wireless Login Agent”, please keep this window open* while you are on the Internet.

Disconnecting:

Re-open the Login Agent window and click on LOG OUT.
