HOW TO FIND BIOGRAPHICAL INFORMATION

I. SEARCHING THE ONLINE CATALOG

Search the library's online catalog to find the title and location of materials in the library. The link to the catalog is available from the library web site <http://www.sunysccc.edu/library>. Select **Find Books/Media** and **Find Books/Media in This Library**. Type your keywords in the **Basic Keyword Search** text box and select **Subject** as the field to search. Examples of some subject entries that appear in our catalog are listed below.

IV. ELECTRONIC DATABASES

Electronic databases that contain full-text articles and reference sources may be used to find biographical information. These databases are available online at the Begley Library web site <http://www.sunysccc.edu/library/>. Select the links **Find Articles** and **List of All Databases A-Z**.

- **Literature Resource Center**
Provides access to biographical, bibliographical, and critical analysis of authors and their works.
- **CredoRef**
Contains a collection of online reference books. Once you have selected the database, select the links **Browse Topics** and **Biography**.
- **Virtual Reference Library (Encyclopedia of World Biography)**
Features biographies of notable historic and current figures from around the world. Once you have selected the database, select the link **View Publications** from the *Biography* category and the link **Encyclopedia of World Biography**.

Some other general databases that contain full-text articles like **Academic Search Premier (EBSCO)** and the **New York Times Full Text Archive** may also contain biographical information.
