

HOW TO FIND INFORMATION ON SOCIOLOGY

I. SEARCHING THE ONLINE CATALOG

Search the library's online catalog to find the title and location of materials in the library. The link to the online catalog is available from the library's web site <http://www.sunysccc.edu/library>. Select **Find Books** and **Find Books in This Library**. Type your keywords in the **Basic Keyword Search** text box and select **Subject** as the field to search.
