



How to Find Information on Wine

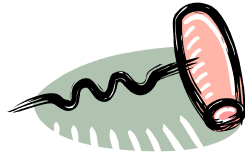

The following is a guide to assist you in navigating your hospitality and tourism needs as they relate to the dynamic world of **WINE**.

I. Searching the Online Catalog

To find information in books on topics related to wine, search our **online catalog** under subject headings such as:

From the library home page, select the links **Find Books/Media** and **Find Books/Media in This Library**. Select **Basic Keyword Search** and then **Subject** as the field to search and enter your text. A list of records will display. A **Basic Browse Search** brings you to an alphabetical list of information depending on the index that you have selected. Advanced searching is available.

II. Circulating Books

Books that may be checked out with the call numbers PS-Z are on the first floor behind the Reference Collection. Books with the call numbers A-PR are on the second floor. Circulating books can be found in the **online catalog** using the search words listed above.

Many books on wine can be found in the “TP” section.

III. EBooks

The online catalog contains links to full-text electronic books which may be “checked out” for 24 hours. A **netLibrary** account needs to be created to check out eBooks. Ask a librarian if you need assistance!

VINIFERA HYBRIDS (WINE)

Hybrid grape varieties (see Hybrid grapes) or "hybrids" is, in fact, the popular term for a subset of what are properly known as *hybrids*, specifically crossings between one species of the genus *vitis* and another. The scientific definition of a hybrid grape is any crossing (intra- or inter-specific) of two grape varieties. In keeping with the popular definition, however, the ones listed below are inter-specific hybrids where one parent is a European grape.
