ACADEMIC BASED PROGRAMS:

Most academic programs offer some sort of experiential learning component such as an internship, field practicum, directed study, or work requirement. These experiences can range from 8-20 hrs/wk (for 15 weeks), full-time summer experiences, 1-2 day field observations, or special projects that allow students to work on tasks or with issues related to their field of study. Each academic department manages their own "credit-based" offerings and determines how unique experiences are integrated into the student's degree program.

EXTRA-CURRICULAR OPPORTUNITIES:

Through the use of clubs and organizations on campus, students have the opportunity to expand their own awareness of themselves and the communities they wish to connect with. They prepare for competitions within their field of study, coordinate site visits to businesses, host speakers who provide industry insight, attend conferences, and fundraise or volunteer on special community projects.

CAMPUS SUPPORT SERVICES:

The Career & Employment Services office serves as a "Center Of Influence" that students use to develop leads, strengthen their ability to communicate individual strengths and goals, and to create a strategy that will lead to future opportunities. Our staff specializes in developing "in-time" connections with local partners who are open to accepting students who are motivated to learn. We help students understand that developing work related experience can happen in many different ways and according to their life schedules, they have the power to design their own unique training. This office also coordinates "non-credited" internships, on-campus recruiting, classroom speakers, and career expos that highlight career and internship opportunities.
