## **Placement Rates and Student Employment**

To assess student outcomes, SUNY Schenectady surveys all graduates six months after graduation. The response rate to these surveys has been declining for years. It has only been 10% for the last two years. The data below aggregates all available data from the last two years into one college-wide score. Unfortunately, SUNY Schenectady cannot currently disaggregate this data by major, since the denominators would be too small to be valid.

**Student Employment:** Forty-three percent of the students said their primary goal was to seek employment after graduation. The table below shows that 72% of the respondents are employed full-time with an average salary of \$43,200.

**SUNY Graduate Wages Tool:** Another resource for salary data comes from SUNY Systems. SUNY has partnered with the New York State Department of Labor to create a public SUNY Graduate Wages Tool - <u>https://www.suny.edu/gradwages/</u>. Using this tool, a user can choose a college and different majors to compare wage outcomes after 1, 2, 3, 5, and 10 years.

**Transferred to a 4-year college or university:** Fifty-seven percent of the students said their primary goal was to continue their education after graduation. The table below shows that 72% of the respondents are enrolled as full-time students at another college or university.

**General Satisfaction:** Finally, to gauge satisfaction with SUNY Schenectady, two additional questions were asked of all graduates. When asked if they would choose to attend SUNY Schenectady if they could start over again, 93% of all students said they definitely would or probably would.
