- <u>STEP 2</u>: Non-Schenectady County Residents must obtain a Certificate of Residence (COR) from their county of residence and submit that to their instructor no later than September 29, 2023. Failure to submit a COR will result in a non-resident rate of pay, which is \$201 per credit. Please note if you submitted a COR in the SPRING OF 2023 you do NOT have to submit another one. Schenectady county residents do NOT need to submit anything.
  - Certificates of residence can be obtained at the County Treasurer's office. Please contact your county treasurer for specifics.
