Trumpet Jury Requirements

All performance concentration and applied music students are required to perform in a jury at the end of each spring semester. Juries are similar to auditions except that everything you have learned throughout the entire year is fair game. Students should revisit all materials from the fall and spring semesters including etudes, recital pieces, and scales. Sight-reading will occur as well and the jury is factored into your final performance concentration grade for the spring semester.

PERFORMANCE CONCENTRATION

Practice Overview: (The repertoire lists below are provided as a guideline and are to be considered flexible based on each student's abilities)
